Place unused or expired medications into a sealed plastic bag. Place narcotics and other controlled substances in a seperate bag.

Scratch out all personal information on prescription label on your empty pill bottles (or packaging) to make it unreadable, then dispose of it in your home recycling or garbage.

Not Acceptable

- X Empty Pill Bottles or Vials
- X PPE (Gloves, Gowns, Masks)
- X Garbage, Recycling, or Packaging
- X Needles, Syringes or Injection Pens
- X Electronics or Batteries
- X Band-aids or Tissues
- X Empty Blister Packs
- X Any waste from long term care facilities, physicians or other commercial enterprises
