### What is acceptable Medication Waste?

#### **Acceptable**

- ✓ Ointment Pots
- √ Topical Creams
- ✓ Pills & Capsules
- ✓ Medical Patches
- ✓ Eye Drops
- ✓ Empty Inhalers
- √ Nasal Sprays
- ✓ Oral Liquids
- ✓ IV or Injectable Medications
- ✓ Full or Partially Full Bottles or Vials (Pail Only)
- ✓ Full or Partially Full Blister Packs

### **Not Acceptable**

- X Empty Pill Bottles or Vials
- X PPE (Gloves, Gowns, Masks)
- X Garbage, Recycling and Packaging
- X Needles, Syringes and Injection Pens
- X Electronics and Batteries
- X Band-aids and Tissues
- X Empty Blister Packs
- **X** Aerosols
- X Cytotoxic Medication



# **Collection Containers, Overpacking for Transport, Labelling & Storage**

Primary Collection Containers must be a lined cardboard box or a white pharmaceutical pail. Examples shown.

- Tie bag securely and place in pail or box. Tape box flaps closed and affix Rx label. Pail should be permanently closed.
- 2 Place waste sticker and barcode labels on the side of the box or pail.
- 3 Store in a secure & controlled area.
  (Store at room temprature refrigeration not required)
